Note from the Director

I have had the most wonderful time working on this show. This is the first show I have been able to direct since Shrek Jr. in 2019, and I couldn't have been more thrilled to take the helm!

In fact, this is our first Main Stage show that we have been able to complete since Frozen Jr. in 2019, and I think it's a fitting one to come back with. Through the pandemic, our normal changed! How we talk to each other, how we function on an every day basis, how we see the world. Buddy the Elf takes the leap from the home he knows, and goes on an adventure to find his real dad, and himself in this new environment.

To me, this story is about finding your people. Buddy is loved at the North Pole, but he has always sensed that he doesn't quite belong there. Part of the reason he goes to New York, in addition to finding his dad, is to find somewhere he belongs—and though the journey isn't perfect, Buddy is able to find a family. The people who accept you for you who you, and love you for it.

That's what theater is to me.

When I left high school, I had no idea what I wanted to do with my life. I was taking general classes towards a degree, but I didn't feel like I was fitting in quite anywhere. I found theater when I was 21 years old. Finally, I found people that weren't afraid to be weird, and an environment where I can be myself and find who I truly am.

That is what I want for Pleasanton Youth Theater Company. Theater does not have to be your lifelong goal, but it can be somewhere you can let loose and be yourself without judgment. Somewhere you can play different characters, enter different realities, and find a version of you that fits best. I hope that our participants and our staff can make that part of their journey here.

This show has been truly a collaborative process. I came in with a plan, but at every turn, this wonderful cast and staff have contributed wonderful ideas to the blocking, choreography, vocal direction, and character ideas to make this a truly unique show. Each of the cast has taken ownership of the characters—naming those that the script did not provide names for, choosing their sign, their Hogwarts House, how they move, and even how they dress! It was inspiring to watch and you will get to see the unique spin that they bring throughout the show!

My journey has taken me in many directions. Coming out of the pandemic I continue to teach, I continue to learn from my job, my colleagues, and my cast. No matter where we are in life, I hope that we can continue to learn from each other and share our experiences. As this show points out—"It's never too late to grow.


Leila Brown | She/Her | Vocal Director
